

MORRIS & BAILEY Cycle-Walkway Clip-On

Overview

Cycle/Walkway Clip-on to the Crosses Road Bridge in Havelock North. This is part of the larger cycle/walkway connection that stretches from Napier to Hastings with funding from the local Rotary Clubs.

Patton's Involvement

Fabrication and installation of the clip-on to the bridge.

Materials

This is approximately 63m in length and is made up of 36 tonnes of steel. The clip-on was required to be fabricated and installed in 3 sections.



Our Comment

The real challenge of this project came in the erection which was successfully coordinated by our team of on-site riggers. The installations issues were the result of the combined weight of each of the sections and the cranes required for installation being greater than the bridge would allow. As such each section had to be secured in place by positioning the cranes on the river banks below while lifting the sections from the truck parked on the bridge.
